#### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Available to a 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year Hampton Roads resident student studying in a commercial real estate field such as finance, interior design, law, architecture, technology, environmental or engineering and is considering a career in commercial real estate.
- Student must have a solid academic record
- Student should be enrolled full-time during the scholarship year (a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester). However, the scholarship fund may be granted to a student whose circumstances restrict their enrollment to six hours.
- Provide evidence of strong leadership skills and community service commitment.
- Applications will be evaluated on cumulative GPA, financial need, and resume. The applicant may be requested to submit to a personal interview with the Committee and provide two faculty members for references or two letters of recommendation.

Submission deadline is February 15, 2010. CREW Hampton Roads Board of Directors will award the scholarship April 2010.
